

## RESOLUTION # 32-2020

### Resolution Requiring Collection and Reporting of Geneva Police Department Data Metrics

WHEREAS, sound decision-making regarding policy and procedures necessitates accurate data collection and dissemination; and

WHEREAS, the International City Managers Association (ICMA), the professional organization that Geneva's city manager(s) (past and present) have long participated in, has an appointed Director of Performance Initiatives who penned a guidance document entitled "High-Performance Policing: Getting the Metrics Right"; and

WHEREAS, the ICMA document states, "any effort to manage with data should focus not on a single performance measure but on a suite of measures" and said measures include not only arrest data but detailed information about types and frequency of calls, response time and length of time on scene, use of force, number and type of officers responding to calls, and other metrics; and

WHEREAS, the Geneva Police Department had provided annual reports to City Council for many years which included not only data from the Uniform Crime Report, but a breakout of total calls by type, response, and resolution as well as a comprehensive report on School Resource Officer activities, Sex Offender Monitoring, and dates and types of trainings offered to every officer in the department; and

WHEREAS, frequent reliable data metric reporting and analysis is currently not provided to the Geneva City Council; and

WHEREAS, the last comprehensive annual report with said data was posted to the City website for the year 2016;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that

The Geneva City Council demands that a data report for the year ending December 31, 2019 be compiled by the Police Chief in at least a thorough a manner as that completed for 2016, and that said report is presented to Council by July 31, 2020 for distribution and posting to the City's website; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that

The Geneva City Council hereby demands that a data report for the year ending December 31, 2020 be produced by the Police Chief for distribution and posting to the City's website no later than two months after the end of said year, and that said practice continues annually thereafter; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that

Beginning with the annual report for 2020, detailed information about types and frequency of calls, response time and length of time on scene, use of force, number and type of officers responding to calls, and other metrics deemed useful and necessary by Council be provided as part of the annual report, and available on a periodic basis as may requested by Council.
